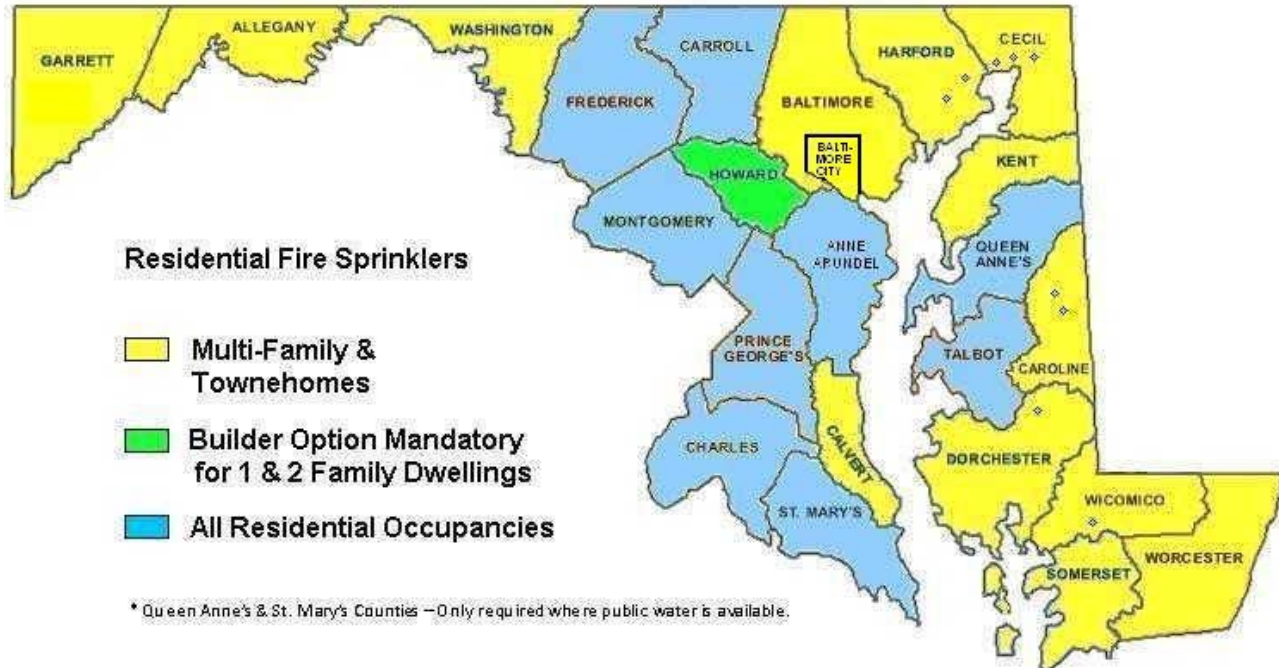


RESIDENTIAL SPRINKLER ORDINANCES IN MARYLAND
